As we bring this year to a close, we would like to thank you for the generosity and attention you've given Spanish Coalition for Housing (SCH) this year. We were ecstatic to continue our mission of building generational wealth through housing counseling, financial education, and advocacy by connecting low-to-moderate-income households to resources that create housing stability, homeownership, and economic mobility.

In 2023 alone, we helped create over 160 new homeowners, helped over 275 homeowners prevent foreclosure and preserve homeownership, and helped over 400 households avoid eviction through our rental counseling. We hosted over 50 educational workshops in both English and Spanish, and our HUD-certified housing counselors continue to prepare prospective homebuyers.

PREVENTING HOMELESSNESS WITH ALL CHICAGO RENTAL ASSISTANCE



Last newsletter, we mentioned our rental assistance program and how it's helped over 3500 residents since 2006. That work would be impossible without our connection with All Chicago.

All Chicago is a citywide organization with four approaches to ending homelessness: emergency financial assistance, community partnerships, data analytics, and training and research. Since 2020, they've provided key monetary help to SCH's clients.

All Chicago helps qualified SCH clients in several ways. For example, they help people pay their first month's rent and security deposit when they're trying to secure a new apartment. Providing up to six months of rent to people facing financial difficulties is another way they help.

According to Elena Hermosillo, our Associate Manager of Programs, it generally takes anywhere from two weeks to two months for a qualified client to get rental assistance through All Chicago. If a client gathers their documents quickly, then their cases move faster.

Elena loves All Chicago because it doesn't require a Social Security number for its clients. If a client can provide a current pay stub or proof of bank deposits, has a lease, has gotten a five-day notice, and resides in Chicago, they're eligible for the program

As many people with Individual Taxpayer Identification Numbers (ITINs) get paid in cash, as long as they can show regular deposits to a bank account, then they will meet the requirements.

SCH is one of All Chicago's top partners, as we receive around 20 rental assistance referrals a week from 311. Since September, the city has provided 257 referrals to SCH via 311. Right now, SCH is only working with 311 referrals due to the high demand for the program, so anyone that would like this assistance must make that call first.

TAKING THE NEXT STEP WITH OUR PRE-PURCHASE TEAM

Our pre-purchase team is always busy! Every year, our HUD-certified housing counselors help hundreds of people navigate the homebuying process.

The team is also proactive about creating new homeowners. They host 48 workshops each year, with two in Spanish and two in English each month. These workshops inform potential homebuyers of their options, and at the end, they receive a certificate that allows them to access more options for financing and assistance with closing costs.

The pre-purchase team also hosts a Homebuyer Orientation each month, which introduces attendees to the basics of buying a home. By attending these one-hour events, potential buyers can decide if they're prepared for the process before committing to two two-hour workshops.

When clients start their homebuying journey, the pre-purchase team is there to get them ready in any way they need. Whether it's helping them repair their credit, explaining their financing options, or more!
